ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

The WEYMOUTH JUNIOR BASKETBALL LEAGUE, including the WEYMOUTH TRAVEL teams, has instituted a Zero Tolerance Policy. Your participation in the WJBL program is considered by the Board of Directors to constitute your agreement to follow this Zero Tolerance Policy.

PLAYERS AND COACHES ARE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEAGUE AND SHOULD ACT ACCORDINGLY

PLAYERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO:

- use profanity, yell or scream at players, coaches, fans or referees
- address the referees – only coaches may question referees
- show disrespect to players, parents, fans, coaches or referees

COACHES ARE NOT ALLOWED TO:

- use profanity
- show disrespect to players, parents, fans, coaches or referees
- yell or scream at opposing players, coaches or fans

SPECTATORS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO:

- use profanity, yell or scream at players, coaches, referees or fans
- address coaches during the game
- address the referees during or after the game
- show disrespect to players, parents, fans, coaches or referees
- coach from the stands

THE WJBL PHILOSOPHY IS:

Coaches will coach, players will play, referees will referee, and fans will support their teams!

Spectators should enjoy the game and are encouraged to give positive feedback to all players. Your conduct is a reflection on you, the team, the coaches, and the town of Weymouth. Conduct detrimental to the League on or off the court will not be tolerated.

Violations of this policy may result in either a warning or ejection from the gym. If necessary, on a case-by-case basis, the Weymouth Junior Basketball Board of Directors will determine if an additional penalty should be imposed (such as suspension from future games or expulsion from the league).
